Part	Paper Code	Paper Name	Course Outcome
Part-I	Paper I	Basic Psychological processes and Biological basis of behaviour (1 <sup>st</sup> half)	This paper deals with basic understanding of psychological processes like sensation, perception, attention, emotion etc. learning, memory, thinking etc. The students will also develop overall concepts about the central nervous system, its structure and function and how it is related to all the psychological processes.
		Developmental Psychology and Educational Psychology (2 <sup>nd</sup> half)	This paper enable students to gain knowledge about the developmental stages of a child including cognitive, social and moral development. Students also learn about the basic processes involved in gaining knowledge like learning, memory intelligence etc.
Part-II	Paper II	Social psychology and Industrial Psychology (1 <sup>st</sup> half)	This paper guide students in understanding how society influences an individual's decision, how public opinion and propaganda operates. On the other half this paper also focuses on how psychological theories are implemented in industrial sectors in preparing proper environment of work and also prevent accident.
		Methodology and Adjustment (2 <sup>nd</sup> half)	This paper focuses on basic concepts needed to carry out research work and how psychological principles can be applied in industry set up. At the end of the course students will also know about mental health, hygiene and how to deal stress in our lives.
Part-III	Paper III	Practical (Experiments and Statistics)	At the end of this course students will learn to use basic statistics like measures of central tendency and dispersion, correlation. This paper also focuses on the practical part of the psychological theories where experiments deal with theories of attention, perception, learning and intelligence.
	Paper IV	Psychopathology (1 <sup>st</sup> Half)	This paper focuses on the abnormal behaviour and the psychological disorders their clinical picture and etiology.
		Application of psychological Tests (Practical) (2 <sup>nd</sup> half)	This paper focuses on the application of psychological tests like test of interest, personality, intelligence and aptitude.
